KOGUCHI Masanori assumed the President of the Japan Atomic Energy Agency (JAEA) in April 2022.

As the president, he has responsibility to efficiently and effectively promote tasks to be addressed, which are development of advanced reactors, promotion of decommissioning task, and contributions of neutron technology to medical field and other industrial fields and so on, incorporating management know-how fostered in private company so far.

He graduated from the School of Law of Hokkaido University in March 1978 and joined the Mitsubishi Heavy Industries (MHI).

Since joining MHI, he has built his career mainly in the fields of finance and accounting and worked on management reform and financial restructuring of MHI.

In June 2015, he became Member of the Board, Executive Vice President, Chief Financial Officer (CFO), Head of Business Strategy Office.

In June 2018, he was appointed Member of the Board, Senior Executive Vice President, CFO.

Then from 2020 to March 2022, he was Senior Corporate Adviser of MHI.

Furthermore, he is now Director of the Japan Association for Chief Financial Officers (General Incorporated Association) and is also focusing on human resource development for CFOs.
