


New Safeguards Technologies Can Build International Transparency

- Remote Monitoring
 - View cameras, sensors from distant locations
 - Less expensive
 - More efficient
- Protect data in Virtual Private Network (VPN)
 - Low cost internet
 - Protect the data with high security
- Regional Cooperation Possible
 - Increase nonproliferation transparency

Possible Regional Transparency Network

- Experiments since 1995: JAEA in Japan, Sandia in US
- Similar cooperation between ROK labs and Sandia
- Sharing of technical knowledge between Japanese, Korean and American experts
