

Treaty and International Convention

Thailand is a party of

- Treaty on Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapon
- Comprehensive test ban treaty
- International convention for suppression of nuclear terrorism
- Convention on Early notification of nuclear accident
- Convention on assistance in case of a nuclear accident or radiological emergency
- Application of safeguards in connection with the Treaty on Non- proliferation with safeguards
- Additional protocol Pursuat INFCIRC/540Corr.
- South East Asia Nuclear Weapon Free Zone (SEANWFZ)
- Asian Nuclear Safety Network (ANSN)



- Approximately 4000 documents in Master Index and IAEA site
- Large number of documents in Hubs and National Centres



Treaty and International Convention on the process of study and Thailand plans to be a party of

- Convention on Nuclear Safety
- Convention on the physical Protection of Nuclear Material
- Joint Convention on the Safety of Spent Fuel Management and on the Safety of Radioactive waste management
- Convention on Supplementary Compensation of Nuclear Damage



Thailand Nuclear Power Program Policy

- Not to develop fuel cycle sensitive technologies enrichment and reprocessing
- Spent Fuel will store at the Nuclear Power Plant for the age of the plant
- Final disposal under consideration




Nuclear Safeguards in Thailand

- Nuclear Research Reactor 2 MWth Triga 19%of U-235 operation since 1962
- Spent fuels are stored in the pool at the reactor site
- No intention to do a research or reprocess of spent fuel
- MTR spent fuels with 93 % U-235 had been shipped to USA
- Thailand has made effort to implement faithfully the safeguards system in the country with good co - operation with IAEA

Thailand Institute of Nuclear Technology(TINT)

- A Governmental public organization established in 2006
- Carrying out nuclear research and development programmes of the country
- Works closely,but independently,with the Office of Atoms for Peace(OAP),the nuclear regulatory body of Thailand and the IAEA

- MOU with China Nuclear Power Research Institute
